- Author's surname and initials (bold italic, centered)
- Academic degree, academic, honorary, military, or special title (italic, centered)
- Name of the educational institution (bold italic, centered)
- ORCID of the author (italic, centered)
- E-mail of each author (italic, centered)
- Surname and initials of the scientific supervisor (for students), academic degree (italic, centered)
- Abstract in the language of the manuscript (italic, recommended 3–4 sentences)
- Keywords in the language of the manuscript (italic, recommended 4–7 words or phrases)
- Main text, width-aligned, without page numbers
- In-text citations must follow APA style
- Reference list at the end of the manuscript, in alphabetical order, titled "Literature" or "References", formatted according to APA Style.
